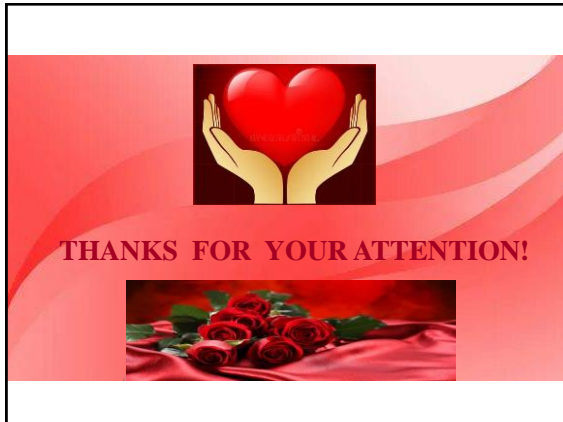

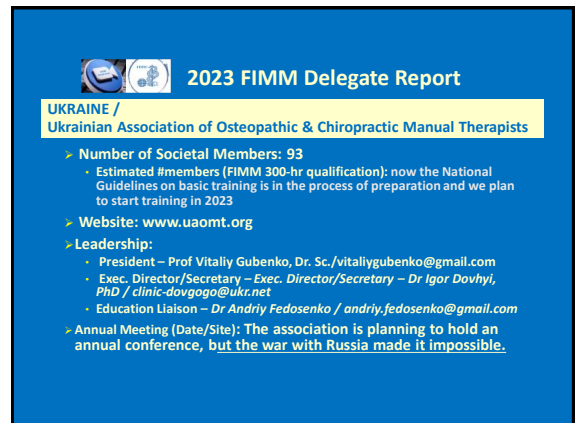

During 2021-2023, we completed the creation the program and work plans) of a 300-hour training program for a Manual/Musculoskeletal Medicine specialist in Ukraine according to the FIMM Recommendations on Basic Education and Safety, version 3.1 (2013). We formulated Core topics and Syllabus of our 300-hour program. This training program consists of 2 levels:

- 1)Basic level and
- 2)Advanced level,
- totaling 304 hours of training together.



**Implementation of the project on Education of FIMM**

In 2023, after the end of the war, the UAOMT plans:

- Discuss of the 300 hours Curriculum with other MM organisations;
- Accept the 300 hours Curriculum under umbrella of UAOMT;
- Inform the Ministry of Health of Ukraine about such initiative;
- Start studying the correspondingly created first level program - Professional postgraduate education certificate course "Basics of manual medicine", with the training of doctors on the first three educational modules.

## 2023 Societal SWOT Analysis

**UKRAINE /**

- **Strengths**
  - The vast majority of members are medical doctors. So, we are following scientific biomechanical and neurophysiology principles
  - Enthusiasm, altruism & innovative behavior of members
- **Weaknesses**
  - First of all, we need an end to the war, peace in the country, reconstruction
  - UAOMT currently have limited channels for sharing and disseminating knowledge on M/M Medicine among our Ukrainian colleagues, such as the Journal, Research and Training Center
- **Opportunities**
  - The acceptance of M/M Medicine in Ukraine is traditionally good, with a belief in efficacy
  - Common trends among the young generation of Ukraine: desire to integrate into international communities; learn foreign languages, etc.
- **Threats**
  - Deficiency of Law regulation leads to low perceptivity of international diagnostic and treatment standards
  - Treatment paradigm among medical society in UA is more pharmacology oriented
  - The lack of a specialty in manual medicine in Ukraine creates difficulties in the necessary development
